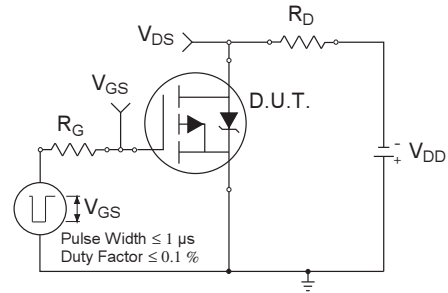

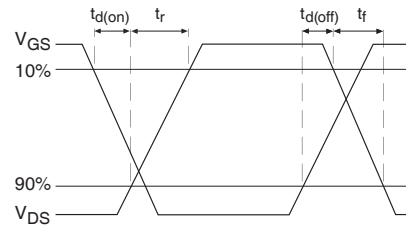

**Fig 5.** Typical Capacitance Vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage

**Fig 8.** Maximum Safe Operating Area



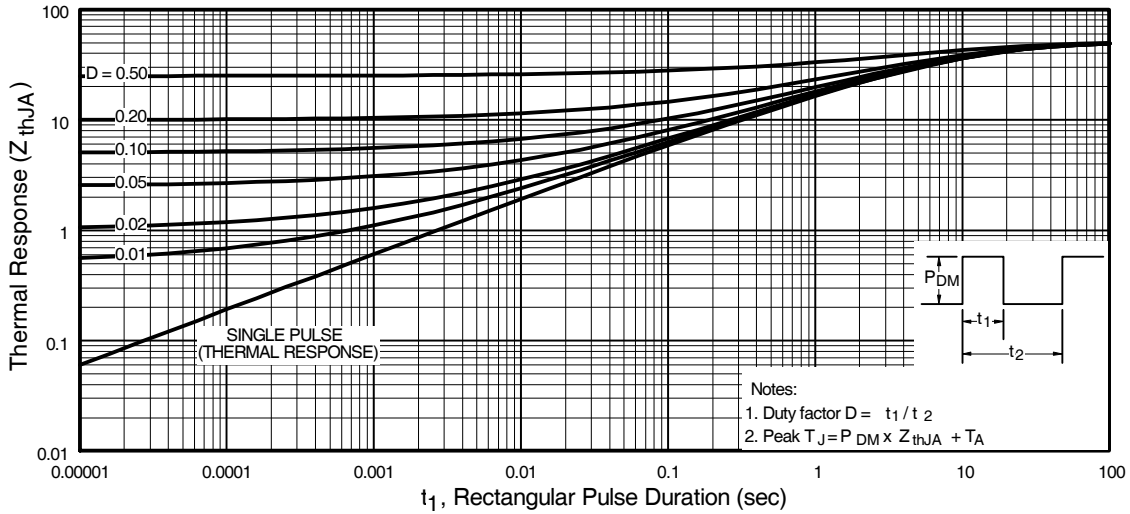
**Fig 9.** Maximum Drain Current Vs. Case Temperature



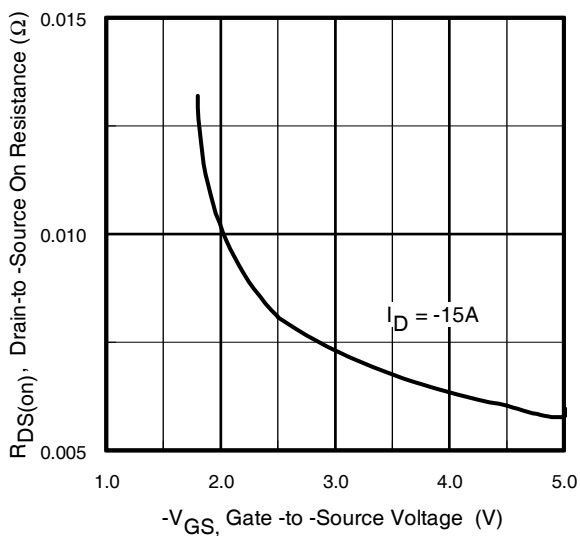
**Fig 10a.** Switching Time Test Circuit



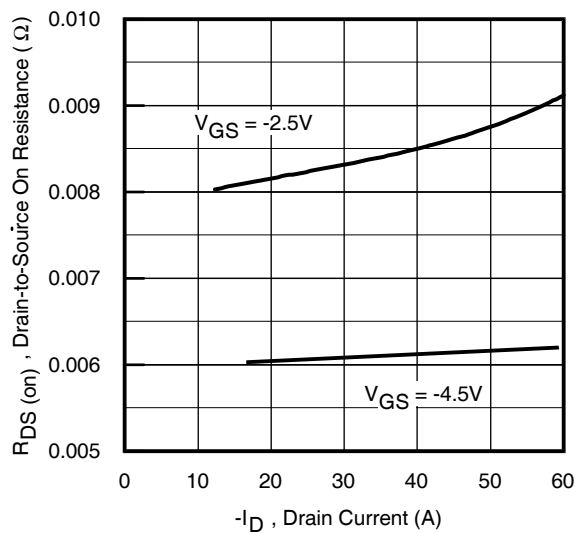
**Fig 10b.** Switching Time Waveforms



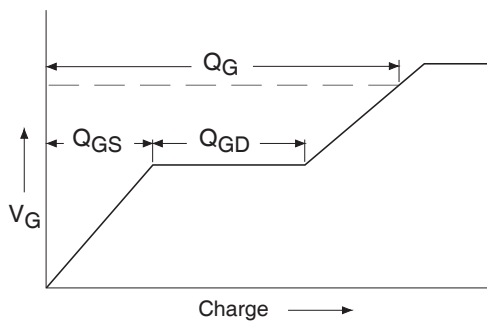
**Fig 11.** Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Ambient



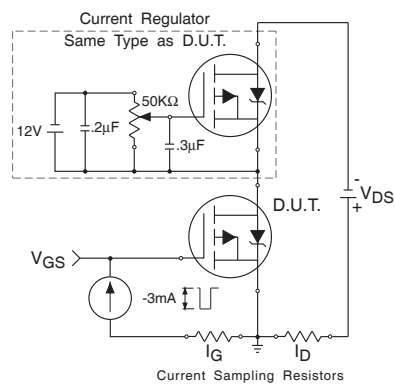
**Fig 12.** Typical On-Resistance Vs. Gate Voltage



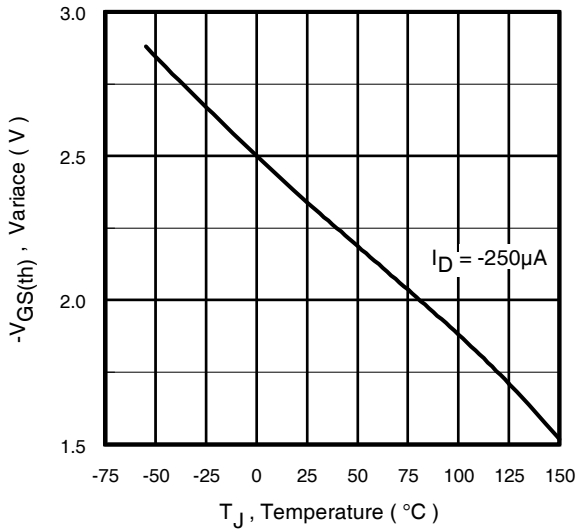
**Fig 13.** Typical On-Resistance Vs. Drain Current



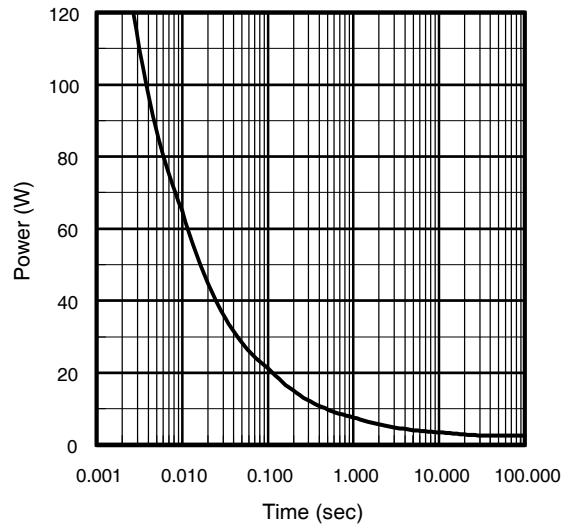
**Fig 14a.** Basic Gate Charge Waveform



**Fig 14b.** Gate Charge Test Circuit



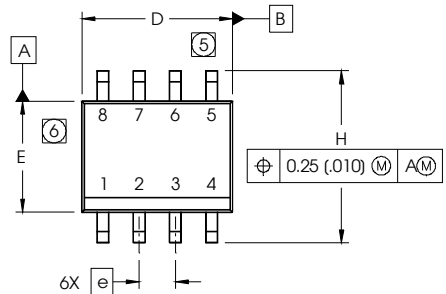
**Fig 15.** Typical V<sub>GS(th)</sub> Variance Vs. Junction Temperature



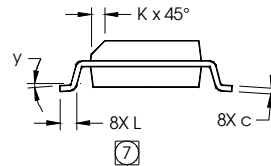
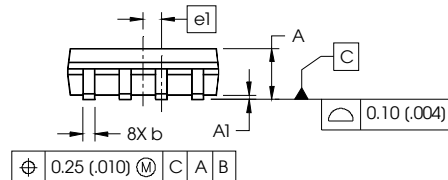
**Fig 16.** Typical Power Vs. Time

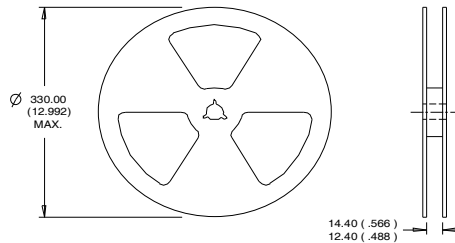
